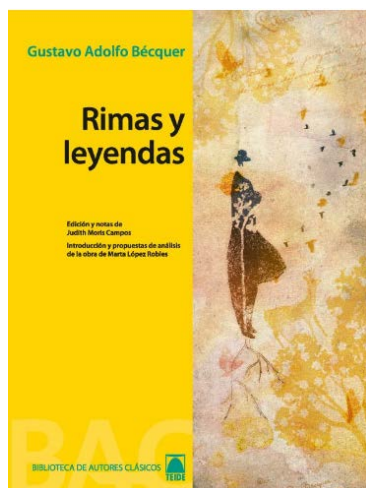

## THE FUTURE TENSE (going to)

• **How is it formed?** verb "to go" conjugated + a + infinitive

**EG :**

**voy a jugar** = I'm going to play

**vamos a beber** = we're going to drink

**va a escribir** = he's going to write

## THE FUTURE TENSE (will)

• **How is it formed?** infinitive + endings for the future tense

• **Endings?**

"I" → inf. + **-é**

"You (sing.)" → inf. + **-ás**

"He/She/it" → inf. + **-á**

"We" → inf. + **-emos**

"You (plural)" → inf. + **-éis**

"They" → inf. + **-án**

**EG :** jugaré = I will play

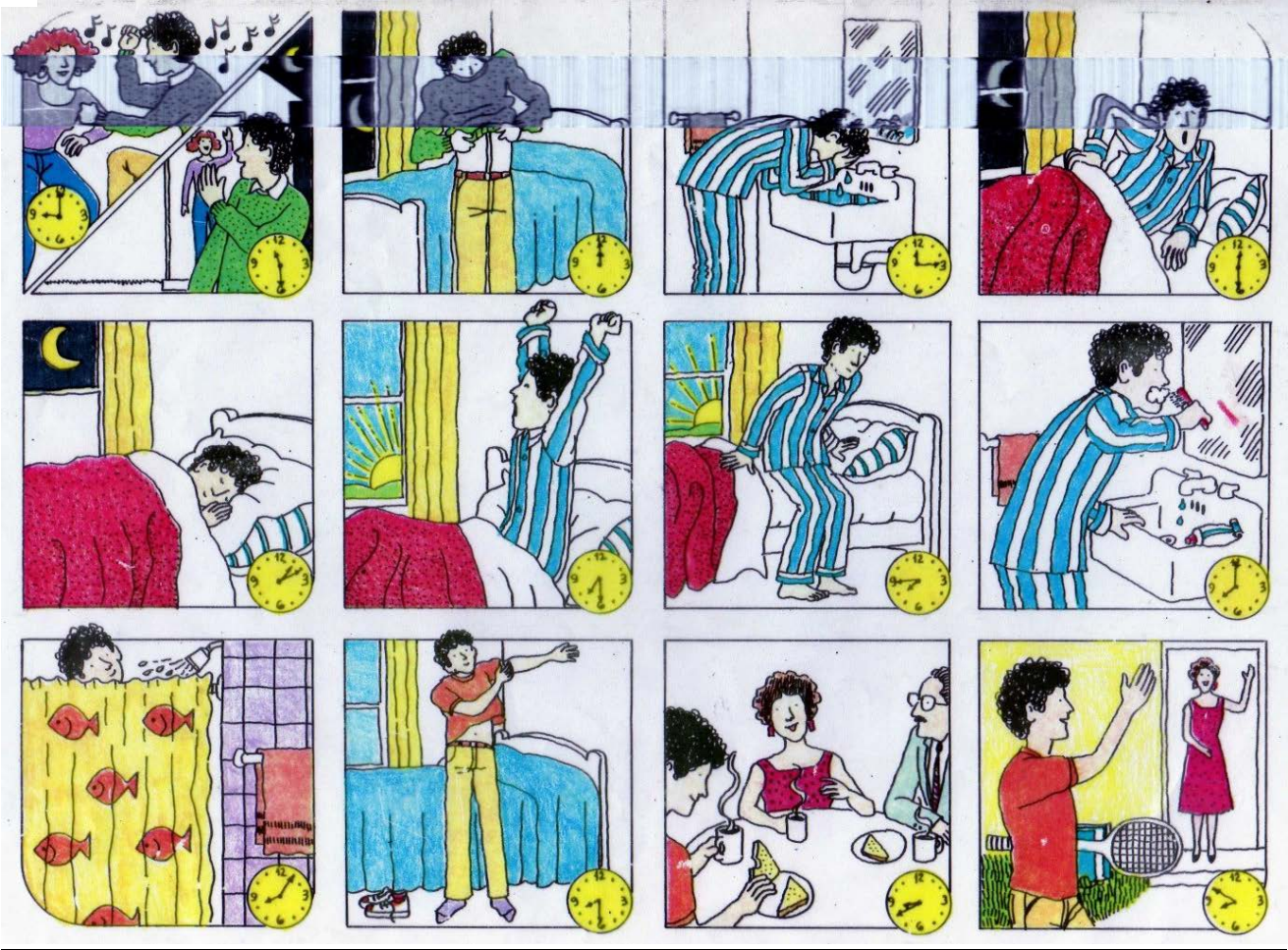
beberemos = we will drink

escribirá = he will write

• **EXCEPTIONS!**

<b>HABER (THERE BE):</b>	habrá	<b>SALIR (TO GO OUT):</b>	saldré
<b>HACER (TO BE):</b>	haré	<b>VENIR (TO COME):</b>	vendré
<b>QUERER (TO WANT)</b>	querré	<b>SABER (TO KNOW):</b>	sabré

<b>DECIR (TO SAY/TELL):</b>	diré	<b>TENER (TO HAVE):</b>	tendré
<b>PODER (TO BE ABLE TO):</b>	podré
